CHAPTER 5

DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE AND DATA ANALYSIS OF CHALAPATHER SHYAM GAON AND ROHON SHYAM GAON

Assam is situated in the North Eastern part of India and is also known as the 'Gateway of the East'. It is a melting pot of different races and cultures. People of different ethnicities and races have migrated to Assam and made it their homeland. With a population of about 3.5 crores; it is a conglomeration of different racial and cultural elements arising out of synthesis and integration which has been continuing since hundreds of years. The languages spoken in Assam belong to three major language groups, i.e. Tibeto-Burman, Indo-Aryan and Tai-Kadai. Hence it would be correct to say that the people of Assam live in a multi-ethnic, multi - linguistic and multicultural society.

The two villages selected as field area for the research fall under Charaideo district of Assam. Charaideo originated from the Tai Ahom word 'Che Rai Doi' or 'Doi Che Rai' which means the 'shining city on the hills'. It was the capital of the Ahom kingdom established by the first Ahom king Chaolung Sukapha in 1253 A.D. Charaideo is famous for many historical sites including the 'Maidams' or tumuli of Ahom kings and queens which can be compared to the pyramids of Egypt. Charaideo was a part of Sivasagar

district until 15 August 2015 when it was formally declared as a new district. The two villages i.e. Chalapather Shyam Gaon and Rohon Shyam Gaon have been selected as micro field for extensive investigation.

Chalapather Shyam Gaon

Chalapather Shyam Gaon is situated in Sonari revenue Circle of Charaideo district of Assam. It is located in 27.0264°N latitude and 94.9117°E longitude. The village was established in the year 1868 A.D. by few men and women who migrated from Disangpani Shyam Gaon which is also in the Charaideo district. According to oral traditions, the main cause of their migration was increase in population and shortage of arable lands. The villagers wanted to settle near the Safrai River which lies in the South of Disang River as the land was fertile. But the area was full of wild elephants, tigers and otherwild animals. The place witnessed frequent tiger attacks as tigers frequented the village and roamed freely there. Hence the place came to be known as Tsu La (Tsu-Tiger, La-land) i.e. the place inhabited or frequented by the tiger. Chala is the corrupted form of the Tai word 'Tsu La'.

Chalapather is situated just sixteen kilometres far from Sonari, which is the district headquarters of Charaideo district. To the Northern side of the village flows the Disang River (tributary of Brahmaputra). Rajgarh, built during the time of Ahom king Susengpha also lays towards the North. To the Southern side lies the Chala Reserve Forest. To the East lies the Khona Tea Estate and to the West lies the Chala Changmai Village and Lakua Tea Estate.

Rohon Shyam Gaon

Rohon Shyam Gaon is situated in the Sonari revenue circle of Charaideo district of Assam. It is located in 27.1106°N latitude and 95.1217°E longitude. The village came into existence in the year 1919 A.D. after few men and women migrated to the present location from Chalapather Shyam Gaon which also lies in the Charaideo district. According to oral traditions, the cause of migration was increase in population in Chalapather village and search of arable land. Rohon Shyam Gaon is situated just twenty one kilometres far from

Sonari, which is the district headquarters of Charaideo District. Nagaland border is only a few kilometres away from Rohon Shyam Gaon.

To the North of the village lies Rohon Gohain Gaon and 1 No Rohon Pathar. To the South lies the Timon River. To the Eastern side of the village lays the Bishnupur Tea Estate and to the West lies Rohon Changmai Gaon.




Figure 5.2 -Charaideo District Map





Figure 5.3 -Sketch Map of Chalapather Shyam Gaon











Table 5.5 shows distribution of population by spatial distance of marital alliance of Chalapather Shyam Gaon. The highest number of brides i.e. 50(27.47%) belong to the same village. Next to Chalapathar comes Disangpani Shyam village which is at a distance of 06 km from where 18 (9.89 %) brides'came.16 (8.79 %) brides also came from Rohon Shyam Gaon/Sapekhati which is 12 km away from Chalapather Shyam Gaon. The farthest place from where bride was brought in Bongaigaon which is at a distance of 589 km from Chalapather Shyam Gaon. Brides were also brought fromother states such as Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland.














Figure 5.10.1






Figure 5.11.1






Figure 5.12.1
